

Social Prescribers

As part of our Primary Care Network with Strawberry Hill Medical Centre and the Downland Practice in Chieveley, we have recruited two Social Prescribers who will share a full time role working across the three practices.

The role of a Social Prescriber is designed to support patients with a wide range of social, emotional and practical needs. An example of patients who may benefit from the input of the social prescribers are patients with mild to long term mental health problems, vulnerable patients, patients who are socially isolated and those frequently accessing primary or secondary care. The GPs will identify patients they think would benefit from the input of a Social Prescriber and, with the patient's permission, the GP will ask the Social Prescriber to contact the patient. We anticipate that our Social Prescribers will be available from mid-November.

NHS App

Just a reminder that the new NHS App, which is available from the App store, allows patients to access the same services that are provided by our online access service, on your phone or tablet. If you do not currently have online access, please bring two forms of ID; one photo and one proof of current address into the surgery and our receptionists will give you an access code.
